## FENDER LINER MODIFICATIONS FOR WHEEL CLEARANCE

G8X M2/M3/M4

## **DISCLAMER**

Fender screen kit (CBB16-24-5470) will need to be purchased to be able to run Michelin Pilot Sport 4s 295/30R20 (Front) | 305/30R20 (Rear) tires.

The following modifications worked for Michelin Pilot Sport 4s 295/30R20 (Front) | 305/30R20 (Rear) tires, and our ride height and alignment specs.

Michelin Pilot Sport 4s 285/30R20 (Front) | 295/30R20 (Rear) tires, with our ride height and alignment specification, did not require modifications.

MODIFICATIONS MAY VARY DEPENDING ON TIRE BRAND, TIRE SIZE,
RIDE HEIGHT, AND ALIGNMENT SPECIFICATIONS



## **FRONT MODIFICATIONS**

- 1. Start by removing the front half of the right and left front fender liners, the cutting procedure is the same for both sides.
- 2. Mark the outer edge of each fender liner in 2 places as shown, and trim off the plastic material encircled by the marks, Photo #1 and #2.



Mark outer edge of liner for cutting







3. Next at the front of the liner cut out the 6 outside louvers marked in the photos, Photo #4 and #5



4. Before reinstalling the front liners, the final modification to the front is to sand down the small edge of the fender that protrudes out from the clamp that holds it to the bumper skin, just behind the headlight and by the wheel opening, See Photos # 6 and #7.



These instructions assume that the person installing these parts is a BRAND CERTIFIED MECHANIC and are NOT step by step instructions on how to disassemble and reassemble the car.



## **REAR MODIFICATIONS**

5. Remove the left and rear fender liners, mark the outer edge of the liner as shown and cut out the pat you have marked, Photo #8 and #9

Mark outer edge of rear fender liner as shown here.


